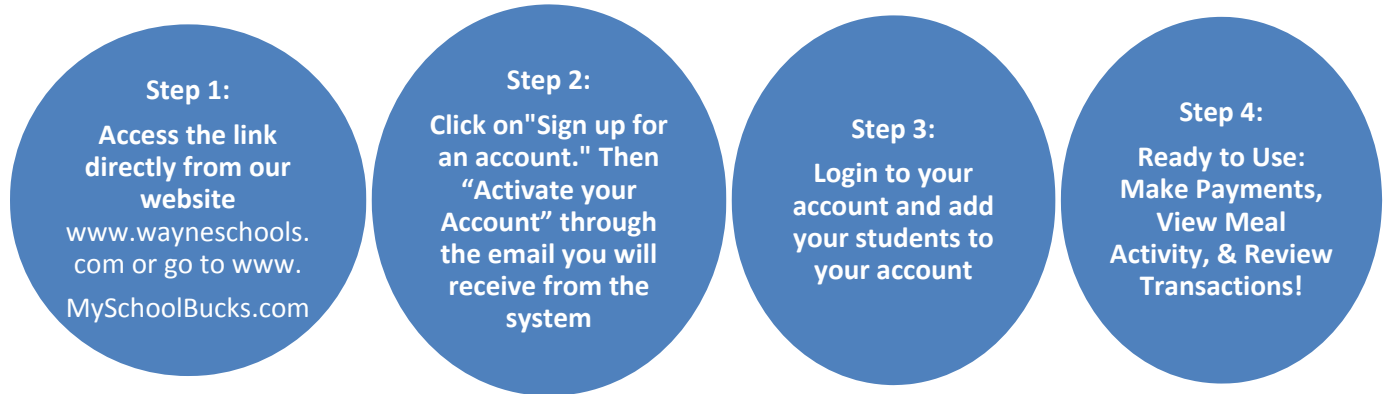
**Benefits of using Online Payments:**
